

We would like to suggest that you keep on file the documentation for the endorsement of the Study Group which you have already submitted to EASD and send this again together with the remaining documentation required for successful endorsement before the deadline:

- A provisional board consisting of 7 people should be proposed.
- Draft by-laws should be proposed.
- A short report (one page) on the aims and planned activities of the study group should be sent to EASD for publication in the News Section of Diabetologia in order to inform the membership and to invite other members of the Association to join.
- A report of the study group's activities until 31 March should be sent to EASD to be tabled at the April Executive Committee Meeting. The Executive Committee will then forward the proposal to endorse the study group to the Council which convenes during the Annual Meeting.
